



Self-Closing Box

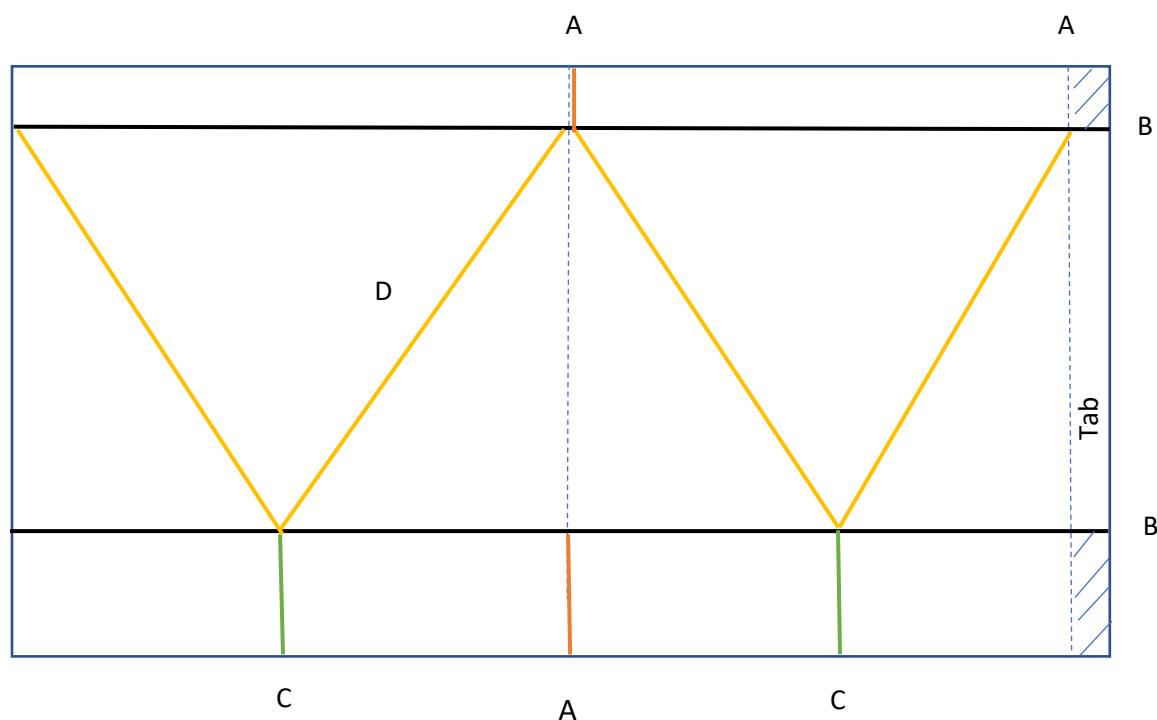
This great little box holds a Ferrero Rocher and would make a great table gift at a Wedding or on the Christmas table.

So, what do you need to make this Self-closing Boxes....

A piece of Designer Series Paper (DSP) cut at 13.6 x 10.8cm (5-3/8 x 4-1/4)

- A- Score along the 13.6cm side at 6.4cm (2-1/2"), 12.7cm (5")
- B- Score along the 9.5cm side at 1.6cm (5/8"), 7.9cm (3-1/8")
- C- Score along the 13.6 cm line at the bottom of DSP up to the next score line running parallel at 3.1cm (1-1/4"), 9.5cm (3-3/4")
- D- Score in diagonal lines as drawn below using either a score board or ruler and stylus.

After all lines have been scored, fold & burnish score lines.

Trim away shaded sections of Tab as above.

Cut at Score lines of A & C – Top & bottom of box only to the parallel score lines marked B.

Along the bottom of box cut out small wedge – this will fold in to make the base of the box.

Place Tear & Tape on Tab and fold over sealing the side of the box. While the box is folded flat use a corner rounder from the Detailed Trio to round the corners on the top of the box.

Use Tear & Tape to close the bottom of the box.

Your box is now complete, and you can decorate as you wish.

Please Note: I have changed the size of the box since making the video. I have made the tabs that form the base of the box longer to give more strength to the bottom of the box.
