Supplies

Stamp Sets/Bundle

- Handsomely Suited Stamp Set

Card Stock/Designer Series Paper (DSP)–

- Well Suited Designer Series Paper
- Real Red
- Basic White
- Night of Navy

Stamp Pads

- Night of Navy

Other Products

- Tailored Tag Punch
- Dimensionals
- Multi-Purpose Glue
- Ceramic Coasters or Square Tiles
- Mod Podge – Washer Safe Gloss
- Felt or cork

Measurements – Metric A4

- Card Base Real Red: 14.9cm x 21 cm, score 10.5cm
- Mat Night of Navy: 10 x14.4cm
- Panels DSP – 3cm x 9cm, cut one in each design of 4 coordinating DSP
- Panel Mat Basic White - 3.2 x 9.2cm, cut x 4
- Sentiment Basic White – 10 x 6cm
- Card Insert Basic White – 10 x 14.4cm
- Card Insert strip – 2 x 14.4cm
- Coasters – 9 x9cm cut one in each DSP or Tile size less 1cm

Measurements – Imperial US Letter Size

- Card Base Real Red: 5 ½ x 8 ½", score 4 ¼"
- Mat Night of Navy: 4 x 5¼"
- Panels DSP – 1 x 3 ⅝", cut one in each design of 4 coordinating DSP
- Panel Mat Basic White - 1 ⅛ x 3 ¾", cut x 4
- Sentiment Basic White – 2 ½ x 4"
- Card Insert Basic White – 4 x 5¼"
- Card Insert strip – ¾ x 5¼"
- Coasters – 3¼" cut one in each DSP or Tile size less ¼"

Card Instructions

1. Cut all required cardstock and Designer Series Paper to measurements given
2. Adhere DSP panels to the Basic White Panels.
3. Adhere the matted panels to the Night of Navy mat, evenly spacing them
4. Adhere the mat to the card base.
5. Using Night of Navy Ink stamp the sentiment onto the piece of Basic White.
6. Using the Tailored Tag Punch, punch out the sentiment. Place dimensionals onto the back and adhere to the card front.
7. Adhere the Insert Strip onto the bottom of the Basic White Insert leaving approx. .5cm or ¼" of Basic White below the DSP
8. Adhere the Insert into the inside of the Card.

Coaster Instructions

1. Coat back of the DSP with Mod Podge and adhere onto the coaster. Let dry.
2. Using a sponge brush coat the DSP 2-3 times allowing the Mod Podge to dry between each layer. **Dishwasher-Safe Mod Podge is water-based and top rack dishwasher-safe, dries hard with no tack.
3. Or Spray with a Varnish (non-Yellowing). Give them approx. 6 coats...drying inbetween each coat.
