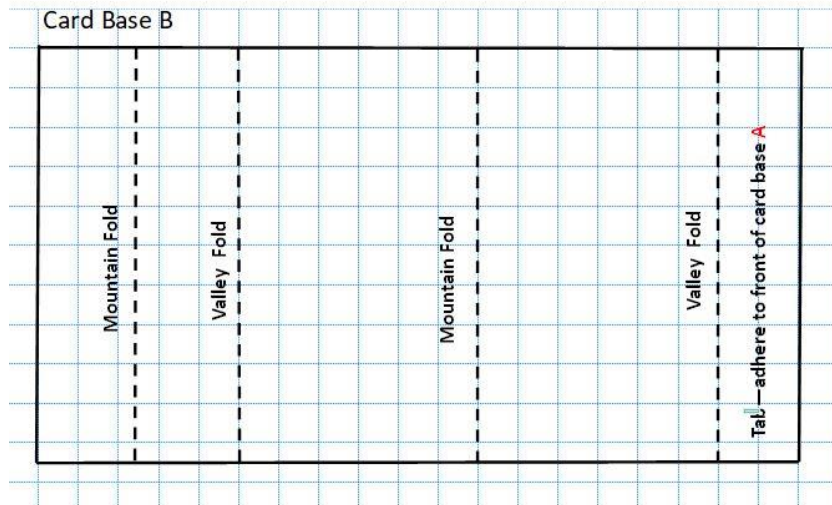

Instructions

1. Cut and score cardstock to measurements given.
2. Die cut from each colour, numbers below are only approx. you may want more or less.
 - a. Night of Navy – 6 x grass
 - b. Soft Suede – Mushroom stems long x 3, Short x 3
 - c. Early Espresso - Mushroom stems long x 4, Short x 4
 - d. Poppy Parade – Mushroom tops x 3
 - e. Pale Papaya – Mushroom tops x 6
 - f. Calypso Coral – Mushroom tops x 5
3. From DSP die cut
 - a. Mushroom Houses x 3
 - b. Gnomes x 3 (2 for card front & 1 for Card Insert)
4. Adhere Card Bases **A** & **B** together.
 - a. **Card Base A** fold and burnish along score line
 - b. **Card Base B** you will have 2 mountain folds in the front and a tab piece after the last valley fold. See diagram of folds.



- c. Adhere the tab to the front of card base. (DSP will hide tab)
5. Adhere DSP to front sections of card base
6. Stamp sentiment onto Basic White strip and adhere to front of card
7. Attach Mushroom houses to the card fronts.
 - a. Back Card front – House on right is glued to card base with Multipurpose glue and house on left has dimensionals to adhere.
 - b. Middle Card Front- House is glued to card base with Multipurpose glue. I didn't take glue to edges, so I was able to slip a mushroom behind later.
8. Attach Gnomes to the card fronts.
 - a. Back Card Front- attach dimensionals behind Gnome and adhere.
 - b. Middle Card Front- attach dimensionals behind Gnome and adhere.
9. Mushrooms and Grass
 - a. Mushrooms – attach Tops to Stems with a tiny dot of multipurpose glue, mixing different stems to tops
 - b. Attach two mushrooms to the back of each grass die. Mixing the colours, so you don't have to of the same mushroom tops on a piece of grass.
 - c. Leave two mushrooms with out grass, one to tuck under the Mushroom House on the Middle Card Front and the other to go on the Card insert
 - d. Attach Mini dimensionals to the back of the 6 Mushrooms/Grass
10. Attach one Mushroom/Grass
 - a. Back Card Front- attach 3 below Gnome and Houses at different levels.
 - b. Middle Card Front- Tuck single mushroom behind the house. Also tuck Mushroom/grass behind Gnome on the right. Another Mushroom/Grass slightly in front of house and Gnome.
 - c. Front Card Front- attach to right of sentiment
11. Card Insert
 - a. Using multipurpose glue adhere the last gnome to inside left bottom corner and a single mushroom just to the right of gnome and slightly overlapping.
