Tools Sponge Dauber Mini Cut & Emboss Machine Adhesives – Multi Purpose Glue, Tear & Tape Dimensionals, Glue dots

Cutting Measurements

Card Base	Soft Seafoam	4 ¼ x 11", score @ 5 ½"	10.5 x 29.9cm, score @
			14.9cm
Card Mat	Basic Beige	4 x 5 ¼"	10 x 14.4cm
Card Front	Soft Seafoam	3 ⅔ x 5 ⅛″	9.7 x 14.1cm
Sentiment	Basic Beige	4 x ⅔ "	10 x 1cm
Card Insert	Basic Beige	3 ⅔ x 5 ⅛″	9.7 x 14.1cm
Stamping	Basic Beige	4 ¼ x 5 ½"	10.5 x 14.4cm
Leaf – Die cut	Basic Beige	2½ x 3″	6 x 8cm

Instructions

- 1. Cut and score cardstock to measurements given above.
- 2. Stamping
 - a. Stamp Flower image twice onto Basic Beige Cardstock using Smoky Slate Stampin' Pad.
 - b. Card Insert-Stamp partial image in right hand corner of the Card Insert.
 - c. Stamp sentiment onto cardstock using Basic Gray Ink.
- 3. Colouring Flower Image see YouTube video Link Here for how I coloured my images
 - a. Using your Blends Colour 1 complete stamped Image.
 - b. 2nd image only colour the smaller flower
- 4. Die Cutting
 - a. Die cut large, coloured flower and the smaller coloured flower with coordinating dies
 - b. Die cut leaf.
- 5. Add some colour to the die cut leaf through the centres of the leaf with the blends, Soft Seafoam and Lost Lagoon Blends.
- 6. Emboss the Card Front with the embossing folder
- 7. With a Dauber ink around the edges of the Card Front, mat, sentiment and insert. On my video I didn't ink the card front or card insert.
- 8. Adhere the embossed card front to the mat and attach the matted card front to card base.
- 9. Adhere the card insert inside the card base.
- 10. Using multi-purpose glue adhere the leaf to the card front going from centre to top right corner, only adding glue to stems.
- 11. Attach large flower to card front with multi-purpose glue.
- 12. Add a dimensionals to the smaller flower and adhere it on top of the same flower on larger die cut.
- 13. Add small dimenionals to the back of the sentiment and adhere to the card front.

Congratulations your card is complete.
