Instructions

- 1) Cut cardstock to measurements given above.
- 2) Score Card Base Back and Top/Bottom frames to measurements above.
- 3) Emboss Back Panel with your chosen embossing folder. After embossing cut the panel into 3 panels per the measurements below. An alternative to embossing could be Designer Series Paper.
 - a) 2.7 x 14.5cm (1 x 5¼")
 - b) 4.2 x 14.5cm, (1% x 5¼")
 - c) 2.7 x 14.5cm (1 x 5¼")
- 4) Adhere Each Panel to the Card Base allowing approx. 1.5mm on both sides.
- 5) Frames
 - a) Cut frames in half along the 4cm edge at 2cm (1½ Edge at ¾"), this will give you 2 of each length, one for the top other for the bottom.
 - b) Fold along all score lines
 - c) Starting with the smallest frames. Add glue to the tab ends, line up centre panel making sure the score lines line up. Repeat for the bottom. Making sure the edges are level with top & bottom of card base.
 - d) Repeat this again with the middle and largest frames. Layering one on top of the other. Until all 3 frames are attached top & bottom



- 6) Window Sheets- Add Tear and Tape to top and bottom of each panel. Remove backing off tape & slide window sheet under first frame, adhesive facing up, press down to adhere to back of the frame.
- 7) Repeat with each layer of window sheet, laying the second sheet on top of the first with adhesive up. Then last on top of the 2nd layer.
- 8) Push the two side panels in a little just to help get the frame to sit correctly.
- 9) Decorate your layers. Don't allow the elements adhered to the window sheet go too wide. If they go wide your card won't sit forward.



When I added my elements to the Cloud Cover Card the elements wend wide, starting from the back. Which means the card can't come forward.

The Crumb Cake Card doesn't have as much in the back and not as wide. This allows the card to be deeper and sit forward more.
