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Painterly Pears

Z-Fold Pop-Up Card- Part 4

Cutting Measurements

	Colour	Imperial/ Letter	Metric/A4
Card Base	Secret Sea	8½ x 5½", score 2½, 4¼	21 x 14.9cm, score 5.25, 10.5cm
Back Panel	DSP	4⅛ x 5¼"	10.2 x 14.6cm
Side Panels x 2	DSP	2 x 5¼"	4.9 x 14.6cm (smidge under 5cm)
Front Panel	Secret Sea	2¾ x 4"	7.5 x 12cm
	DSP	2⅝ x 3⅞"	7.2 x 11.7cm
Middle Panel	Petal Pink	3 x 4½"	7.5 x 12.9cm
	Basic White	2 x 3½"	5.5 x 10.9cm
Hinge	Petal Pink	3 x 3", score ¾, 1½, 2¼	8 x 8cm, score 2,4,6cm

Instructions

1. Cut and score cardstock to measurements given above.
2. Stamping
 - a. Stamp 'Hello' sentiment to the front panel DSP using the Secret Sea Ink Pad.
 - b. Using Petal Pink Ink Pad stamp floral image around the edges of the Petal Pink middle panel.
 - c. On the Basic White middle panel stamp either flowers or splatters in the left corner.
3. Adhere back and side DSP panel to the inside of the card base. Fold first panel to the front of the card.
4. Front Panel, adhere DSP to the front panel and set aside.
5. Middle panel, adhere Basic White panel to the Petal Pink Panel.
6. Hinge
 - a. Fold & burnish the 3 score lines. I would suggest trimming the outer edges by a smidge, so when folded in there is a small gap between them.
 - b. Open the card base, laying flat & with DSP facing upwards.
 - c. Fold outer tabs of the hinge into the centre score line.
 - d. Add adhesive to the 2 outer tabs and glue down either side the card centre fold. The score line in the centre of the hinge needs to line up with the centre fold of the card. This should form a rectangle tube hinge.
 - e. Open and close the card a couple of times to make sure the card opens and folds nicely.
7. Apply glue to the middle-left side of the hinge (middle-right side is not glued to anything) and adhere the middle panel to it leaving a small gap of about 1mm or less.
8. Adhere the front panel to the card. Only putting glue onto the left half of the front panel.
9. Add a few Low-Profile Sparkling dots to finish your card.
