Measurements for one Box

Box Base	Petal Pink	3 x 6 1/2" Score- 3/8", 1, 2 1/2, 3 3/8, 4 5/8, 6 1/8"	7.5 x 17cm Score- 1, 2.5, 6.5, 8, 12, 16cm
Pop-out Right	Basic White	1 3/8 x 6 1/4", score 3 3/8"	3.7 x 16cm, score 8cm
Pop-Out Left	Basic White	1 3/8 x 5 3/4", score 2 7/8"	3.7 x 14.25, score 7.25cm
Tab	Basic Black	2 1/2 x 2 1/2"	6 x 6cm

How to....

In this tutorial, I will guide you step-by-step through creating one sliding gift box. If you would like to make multiple boxes, be sure to watch the accompanying video where I share helpful tips and tricks for batch-making them more efficiently.

1. How I measured for the box.... these measurements were determined by the length and width of camera die cut and the height by the thickness of the heart chocolate
 - Length- 7.4cm
 - Width- 4cm
 - Height- 1.5cm
2. Prepare the Box Base
 - Score your cardstock using the measurements given.
 - Fold and burnish all score lines.
 - Add Tear & Tape down the two tabs
 - Trim small wedges off corners for neat assembly.
3. Create Sliding Mechanism- working with the 2 x 4cm scored panels on the left
 - Cut a 3 cm strip from a plastic sleeve.
 - Add tearing tape along one long edge.
 - Wrap the plastic strip around the box but inside the first of the 4 cm panels.
 - Keep it snug but not tight (it must slide).
 - Peel off tape backing and adhere down. Trim excess plastic.
 - With the join at the very top, add another strip of tape on top of the previous join. (inside edge, not overhanging plastic).

Important: Make sure no adhesive touches outside the plastic, or it won't slide properly.



4. Create & Attach Pull Tabs

- Right & Left Pull Tabs
 - Add adhesive on half the pull-tabs, fold in half.
 - Double thickness adds to the strength of the Pull-Tabs.
- Right Pull-Tab
 - Using the Keeping Tabs Punch, punch out one tab from Basic Black cardstock.
 - Attach punched tab to the one end of the Pull Tab.
 - The tab is wider than white tab strips, trim down to match. If its left wide, then it won't pull back into the box.
 - Stamp sentiment and heart onto the tab, making sure the pull section is on the RIGHT.
 - Turn Pull-Tab upside down/wrong side facing you. Remove backing from tape and adhere the pull tab to the plastic strip. Important: Adhesive will be on the left and black tab to the right.



- Fold 1 cm tab over, remove backing of tape and fold over again at next score line and adhere down. Encasing the Right pull tab inside.



- Left Pull-Tab
 - Add another strip of tape to the right side of plastic.



- Attach the Left Pull-Tab, making sure the folded edges are on the left and cut edge to the right.
- Ensure when tab is pulled it opens in opposite directions.

5. Assemble the Box

- Fold box into shape.
- Carefully glue the side tab to close the box.
- Make sure:
 - The tabs sit between cardstock and plastic layers & not caught on the plastic mechanism.
 - ✓ Test the mechanism.... Pull tab → should slide smoothly



6. Add the Chocolate
 - Add a small piece of strong tape to the center of the sliding panel.
 - Attach chocolate slightly angled.
 - Press firmly to make sure it is adhered.
7. Make the Camera Decoration
 - Stamp and die-cut camera pieces
 - Using Calypso Coral ink pad stamp onto the Petal Pink cardstock the camera body, front panel and lens
 - Onto Basic White cardstock stamp the shutter image
 - In Basic Black cardstock cut the Camera lens
 - Layer and glue pieces together.
 - Attach to front of box.
8. Add Heart Charm
 - Cut ≈10 cm linen thread.
 - Add Adhesive Sheet to back of Real Red Cardstock and die cut 2 hearts.
 - Thread Linen Thread through the small hole on the right side of camera.
 - Sandwich thread between two small heart & trim the length of Linen Thread.
9. Finished!
 - Slide the tab → chocolate pops out 🎁
 - Slide back → hides inside again

10. Tips

- Batch make for speed (cut all pieces first).
 - To create 4 boxes, I used 2 sheets A4 coloured Cardstock
 - 1 sheet 12 x 12 Basic White Cardstock (approx. 8 each size Pull-Tabs)
- Double thickness Pull tabs helps hold the weight of the chocolate.
- Use strong adhesive—chocolate adds weight.
